- The purpose of “the store” is to provide much needed clothing, personal items and other needs for the less fortunate people living in the community. These needy people include some that are homeless and living on the street, families that live on a very limited budget as well as a few that are in need of a little helping hand once in a while.
- The most often items requested include:
 - Non-perishable food items such as canned fruit and vegetables, tuna, salmon, peanut butter, canned meat, tomato products/sauces, pork and beans, spaghetti/pasta, cereal and jam.
 - Personal care items such as hand soaps, tooth paste/brushes, shampoo, deodorant and hand cream.
 - Personal clothing items such as socks along with large and extra large underwear and t-shirts for men.
- The most needed clothing items include:
 - Children’s clothing and outerwear.
 - Ordinary slacks and tops, along with fall and winter coats/jackets for larger men and women. (we have a hard time getting rid of suits for both men and women, especially the smaller sizes)
 - Shoes and boots for the whole family.
- Any items that are not taken at a “community meal” are held onto for the next four or five meals. If they have not been taken, due to the condition that they are in, they are donated to “Goodwill”.
- PLEASE, when donating to “the store”, be careful to avoid clothing items that are ripped or severely stained.
- Any other items such as dishes, books, jewelry, ornaments, toys, games, etc., that you no longer use or need, are well received and greatly appreciated. The above listed items are those that are frequently requested, and or, go very quickly when we have them.
