

Fast facts: KNITwits - Who We are and What we do: We are a small group of knitters within the Runnymede United Church community that knits for the Community Meal and beyond. During the fall and winter months, we get together as a very small 'tight-knit' group known as the KNITwits. Yet in our 5-years together we have produced approximately 200 hats, 100 scarves and 50 pairs of mitts/gloves for those deserving of winter warmth! We started with only \$70 worth of wool - a discounted batch from our local Zellers, and now we get donations of wool from within our community and our ladies always go to garage and yard sales looking for more to be added to the yarn cupboard. To keep ourselves busy in the spring, three years ago, we started making prayer shawls - these gorgeous hand-knitted shawls were made and prayed over for their healing powers of warmth to help individuals in times of illness or crisis. To date, we have made about 25 shawls.

We actively recruit knitters of all skill levels and will teach those that have never knitted before.

Our meetings are only 2 hours per month on the first Tuesday every month in the library (upper floor, above the offices).
